One-Week Transplant Coordinators' Training Programs

MOHAN Foundation in partnership with Manipal Organ Sharing & Transplant (MOST) conducted a training program on Transplant Coordination from March 22 to March 26, 2022 at Manipal Hospitals, Dwarka (MHD) under the aegis of National Organ & Tissue Transplant Organization (NOTTO). The training drew 35 delegates from 7 states: Haryana, Rajasthan, Delhi, Manipur, Gujarat, Sikkim and Uttar Pradesh.
